We are a multi-disciplinary team of professionals experienced and trained in Special Education, Therapeutic Counseling, Social Thinking, and Speech and Language development. We are committed to assisting parents and students develop tools and strategies needed to prepare for life beyond school!

## PHILOSOPHY

**At Lake Pointe Academy** we understand every student learns in different ways. We believe each student has the ability to learn skills needed towards personal achievement and should be encouraged to reach their fullest potential. We believe this occurs when the environment and curriculum is individually suited to their unique learning needs and built upon each student's individual strengths. This commitment is the foundation in our approach and development of our program.

**We accomplish** this through maintaining a calm and nurturing environment, an **Individualized Success Plan** implementing systematic adjusted teaching strategies with evidence-based methodology, within carefully structured and predictable daily routines.

## PROGRAM

**Our program** is designed to build upon each student's individual strengths and minimize challenges in the areas of:

**Social Skills & Relationship Development**

Our curriculum delivers instruction integrating the principles of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA), proficiency learning/standards-based education, and experiential learning through individualized and small group instruction. We strive to provide extra-curricular activities that correspond with our students' special interests which may include rock climbing, bike riding, martial arts, theatre arts, yoga, cooking, field trips, and community service opportunities for further learning.

**Children who demonstrate** behavior that is misunderstood are at risk for disciplinary actions that may in fact increase negative behavior and poor social responses. Left unresolved, this can lead to an increase in behavioral difficulties, risk for lowered academic performance, anxiety, depression, and other mental health concerns, as well as increased family stress and relationship challenges.

## STEPS FOR ENROLLMENT

**ELIGIBILITY:** Lake Pointe Academy is a non-categorical therapeutic school designed for students with academic, social, communication and behavioral needs. Currently enrolling students ages 6 - 14. We are not a psychiatric or behavioral transition program.

### ADMISSION PROCESS:

- 1 Contact the school to schedule an appointment with the Director.
- 2 Complete an application with application fee and deposit to secure space. (Forms available on the website.)
- 3 Application and records will be reviewed by the school team to ensure we can meet the student's needs and parent's goals.
- 4 Placement decisions are made by the admissions team after review of a variety of assessments, current IEP, and interview with the student, family, and consultation with outside professionals when appropriate.
